- 3) Read 1 Corinthians 3:5-7. In this scenario, Paul is saying that we work together to seek and save the lost. What role could you play to be a fisher of men?
- 4) Looking back at question #2 under Opening Discussion, what could you do or offer in the service of the Lord for His Kingdom?

PRACTICAL APPLICATION | Walking It Out
