SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

OPENING DISCUSSION | Let's Get the Discussion Started

- 1) It's the end of May. Who has a flourishing garden? Share pictures with the group if you have them.
- 2) Let's flip that. It's the end of May. Who already has dead plants?

BIBLICAL REFLECTION | What Does God Say About This?

- 1) Read John 11:17-44. The main characters in this story are Jesus, Martha, Mary & Lazarus. Take a moment and talk through the primary tension each of these characters are battling through this story.
- 2) Pastor Rusty wrestled with the tension that everyone in this story AND all of us face – “Jesus is good for later ... but not for now.” We trust His promise to RESURRECT us after we die ... but do we trust Him for LIFE now? Where do you see this in your own life?
- 3) “Jesus wept” in vs. 35. He is fully God, which means He knew what was going to happen, yet He was still swept up in an emotional response. How does that change or strengthen your view on who God is and how He loves?
- 4) In verse 44, Jesus tells the people to unbind Lazarus from the grave wrappings. If that was a picture of your life right now, Jesus has spoken life over you, He's opened the grave ... so what is it in your life that is still holding you back from the fullness of life that Jesus offers now?

PRACTICAL APPLICATION | Walking It Out

Take the Challenge: This may seem a bit morbid, but it could provide important insight. Sit down and write your own obituary. What do you want people to remember about how you lived?
