BIBLICAL REFLECTION | What Does God Say About This?

- 1) Read John 9:1-7. Why do you think the disciples immediately looked for someone to blame?
- 2) Jesus answered the disciples (verse 3), "this happened so that the works of God might be displayed in him." Read Romans 8:28 and Genesis 50:20. What do these three scriptures teach us about God's ability to use difficult circumstances?
- 3) As the story progresses, how does the blind man's understanding of Jesus change?

- 4) Read John 9:24-25. The man says, "one thing I do know. I was blind but now I see." Why is this personal testimony such a powerful witness?
